Make Use of Teachable Moments

Read words together wherever you go: On road signs, billboards, & posters.

Talk about colors, sizes, & shapes in the vegetable aisle of the grocery store. What is the same? What is different?

Give your child the job of folding dinner napkins and sorting silverware.

Include him/her in sorting laundry by size, shape & color, and talk about textures.

Take special outings to the local fire department or post office, all the while giving your child a chance to ask questions.

Be deliberate in your speech. Use concepts words such as up & down, in & out, behind or beside.

Set out puzzles & patterns for your child to duplicate on a special table in your den or kitchen.

Also, prepare your child for Kindergarten by working on self-help skills: Hand washing, toileting needs, buttoning and zipping clothes, eating at the table, and keeping up with their belongings.
