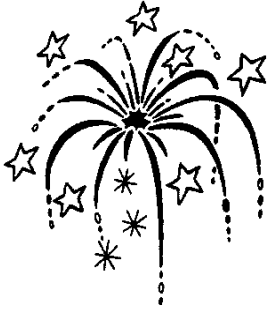

Summer Safety Reminders:

Summer is here and outdoor fun is calling! To get the most enjoyment from summer activities, keep safety in mind.

When children spend time in the water, stay within an arms length and avoid distractions like the telephone. Flotation devices are great for play, but they do not replace the close visual supervision.

Never leave a child alone in a car, even with the windows down. On a summer day, the temperature inside a parked car can reach 120 degrees in 10 minutes, causing a child to suffer from heat exhaustion or even life-threatening heat stroke.

Enjoy sunshine wisely! The sun's

UV rays activate Vitamin D in the skin, which is beneficial, but too many UV rays can be damaging to skin & eyes. Cover up with light clothing, hats, & sunscreen, even on cloudy days!

During hot, humid weather children may lose body fluids through perspiration. To reduce the risk of dehydration, offer water frequently, dress children in clothing that is light-colored & lightweight, and replace damp garments with dry clothing.
